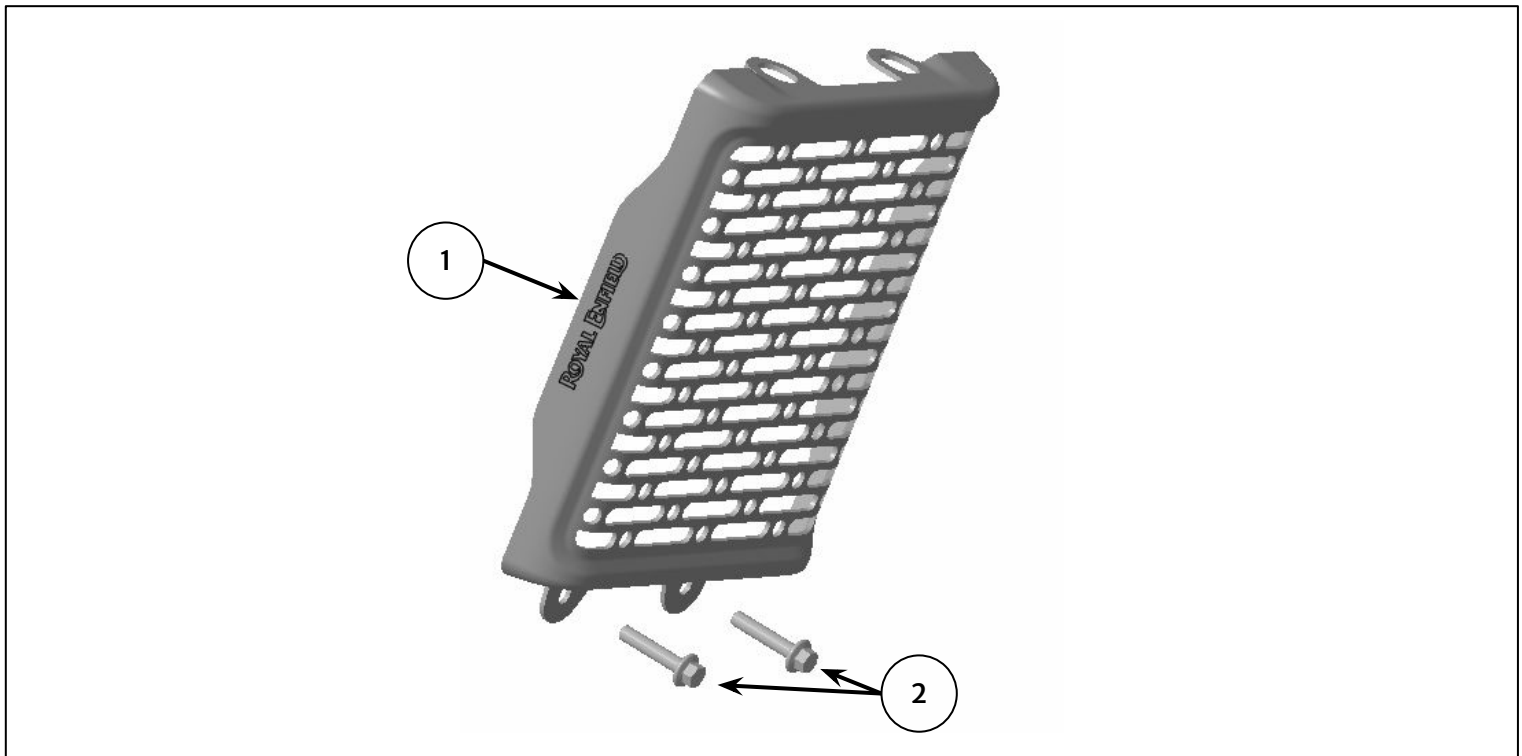

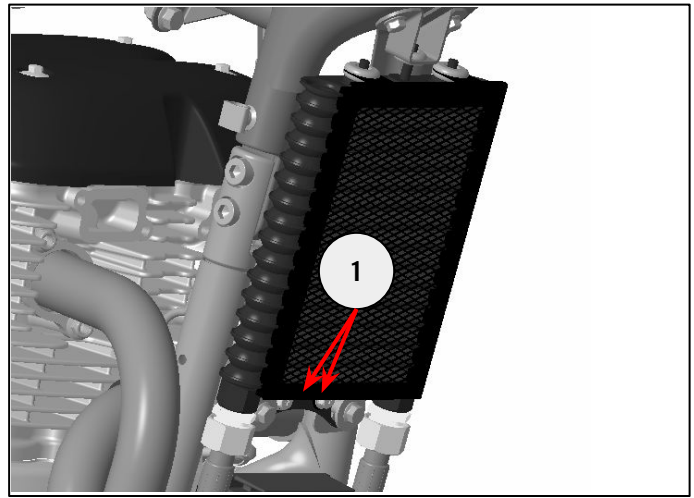
Item	Description	Qty
1	Oil cooler guard	1
2	Fixing, M6 x 30mm	2

For Interceptor Bear, Interceptor and Continental GT models only

1 Remove the two upper fixings and nuts (1). Retain for reuse if the motorcycle is to be returned to its original condition.



10mm socket, ratchet and 10mm spanner

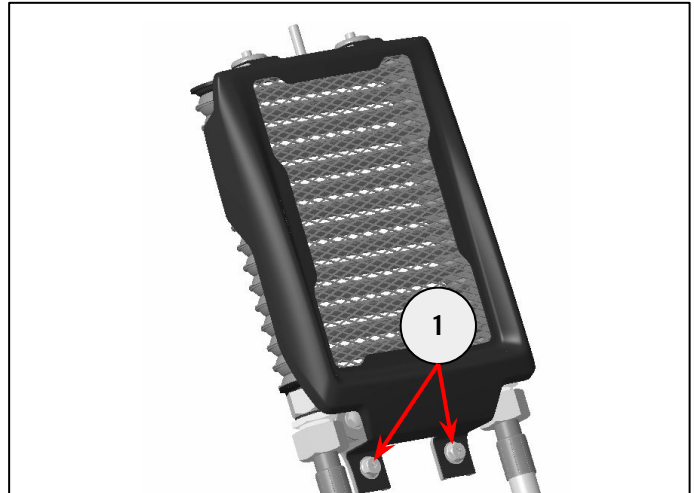


For Super Meteor and Shotgun models only

2 Remove the two lower fixings (1). Retain for reuse if the motorcycle is to be returned to its original condition.

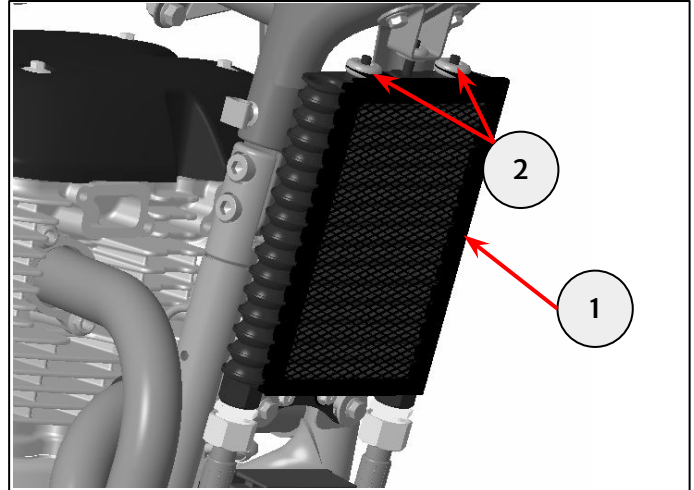


10mm socket and ratchet



All models

3 Pull the standard oil cooler guard (1) towards the front of the bike from the bottom of the guard. Lift upwards to remove the guard from the top locating pins (2). Retain all for reuse if the motorcycle is to be returned to its original condition.



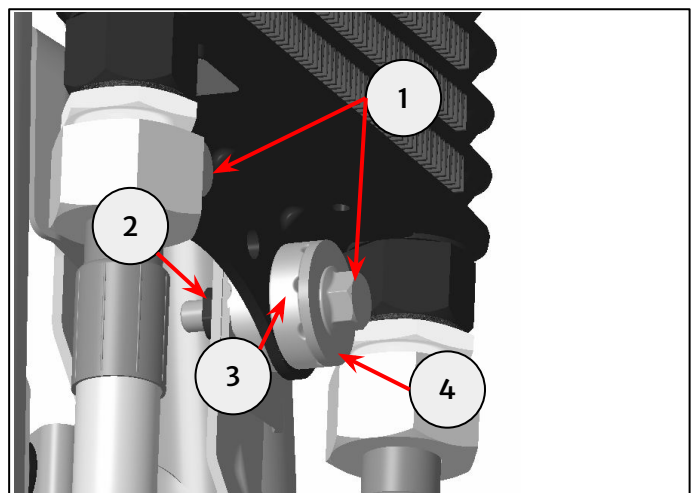
4 Remove the two fixings (1) and nuts (2). Note: some models are fitted with a fixed plate where the nuts will remain in place.

Support the oil cooler, do not allow to hang from its hoses. Ensure both grommets (3) and top hats (4) remain in place.

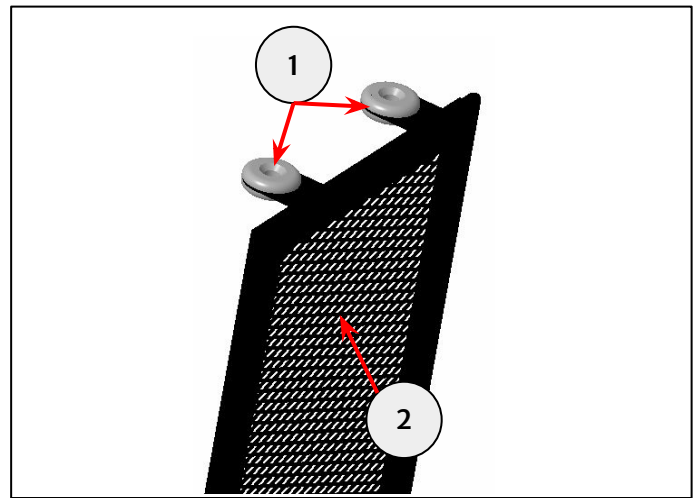
Retain the nuts (if applicable) for reuse. Retain the fixings (1) for reuse if the motorcycle is to be returned to its original condition.



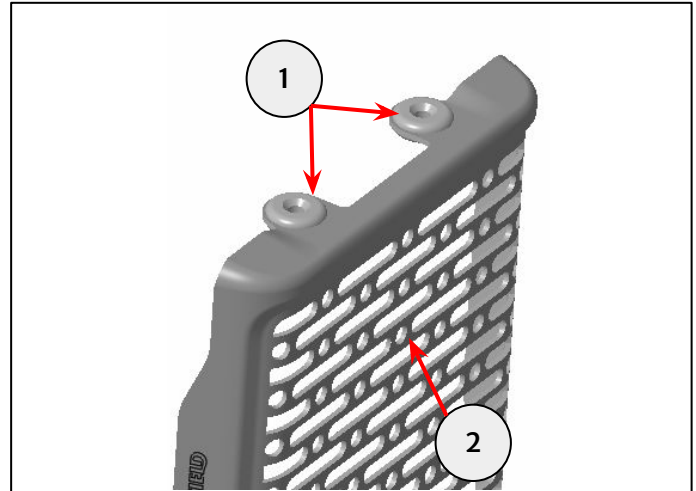
10mm socket, ratchet and 10mm spanner



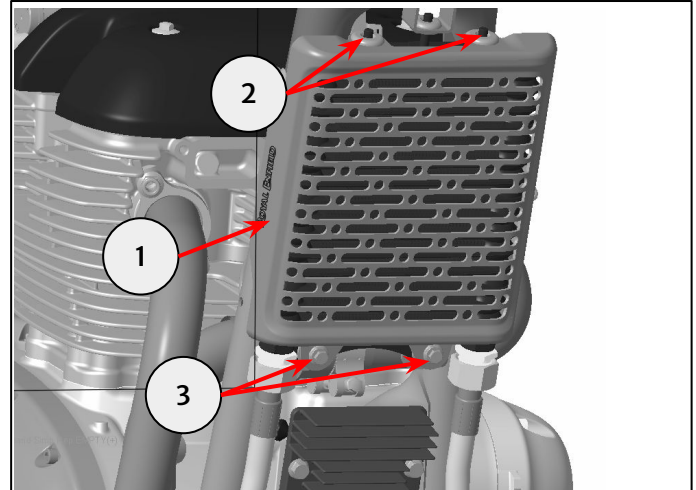
5 Remove the grommets (1) from the standard oil cooler guard (2).



6 Refit the grommets (1) to the new oil cooler guard (2).



7 Locate the top of the new oil cooler guard (1) onto the oil cooler locating pins (2) and push downwards. Using the fixings from the kit and the nuts removed in step 4 (3), secure the oil cooler and new cooler guard to the bottom mounts. Tighten to **10Nm**.
